

What is the Control Center?

- Instant Access to Things you Do Most
- Access from any App or Screen





How to Access the Control Center

Two Methods Depending on your iPhone or iPad

- iPhone with a Home button (iPhone 6,7,8 & SE)
- iPhone without a Home button (iPhone X or 11) also current iPads



Access with a Home Button





Access with a Home Button

Swipe Up from the bottom of the screen

- Place your finger to the right of the Home button
- Slide Up

Press the Home button to Close



Access without a Home Button





Access without a Home Button

Swipe Down from the topright corner of the screen


- Place your finger on the battery icon
- Slide Down

Tap the Screen or Swipe Up from the bottom to return to Home screen




Don's Favorites

- 1. Long Press for Connection Shortcuts
 - WiFi Connect
 - Air Drop
 - Turn off Bluetooth
- 2. Pause Anything that is Playing
- 3. Do Not Disturb Long Press Options
- 4. Brightness and Volune
- 5. Custom Icons
 - Flashlight
 - Calculator
 - Dark Mode
 - Text Size
