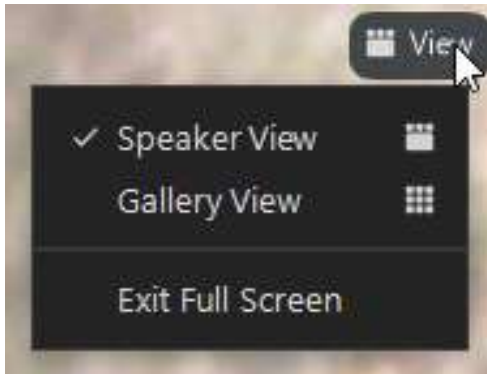

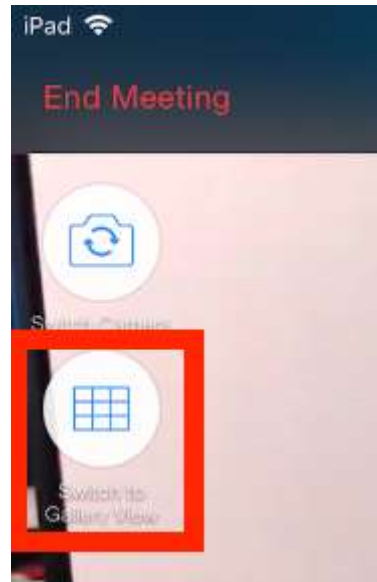

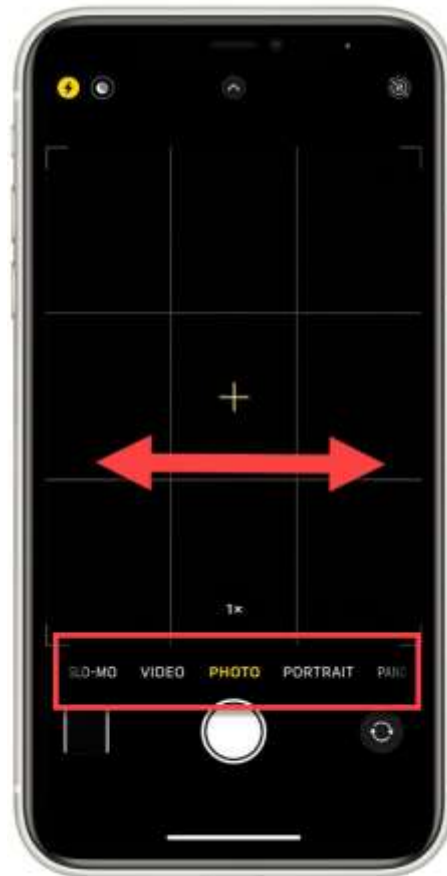


Photo Mode

Flash

Zoom

Timer

Selfies

Filters

Focus

Exposure



Portrait Mode

Two Effects:

1. Bokeh – Blur Background
2. Lighting



Square

Takes a photo with a square, 1:1 Aspect Ratio

Best early format for social media posts

Mode – disappeared from new iPhones

On your Newer iPhone:

- Photo Mode

- Tap Control Arrow

- Tap 4:3 to switch to Square

Move the iPhone
for extra wide angle

Tap arrow to switch
direction

Move vertically

Orientation

FPS - Resolution



Recording Video

Record Button – Red Circle

- Square when Live
- Shutter button on right – Quick Photo

Volume Buttons

Quick Take Video

- Long Press Shutter Button – (iPhone X and later)



Video - Horizontal or Vertical

Horizontal - YouTube or
TV/Broadcast/Film Format

Social Media –
Vertical



Video Settings

Similar to Photos:

- Selfies
- Flash
- Zoom
- Focus & Exposure

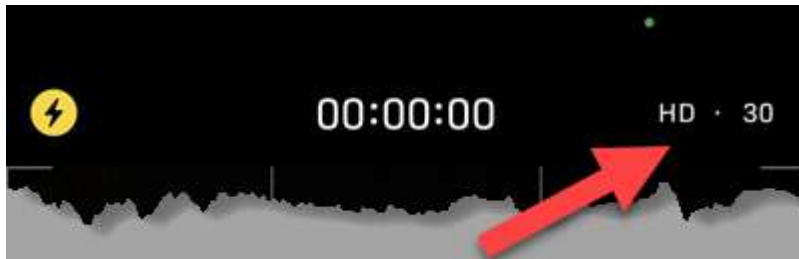


Video Settings



Video FPS & Resolution

Newer iPhones – Quick Toggle
(Upper right)



Older iPhone -
Settings>Camera>Record Video

Video FPS & Resolution

What does your iPhone offer?

Settings>Camera>Record Video

FPS – 24 (low light), 30 & 60

Resolution:

1270 x 720p

1920 x 1080 (HD)

3840x 2160 (4k) – Newer iPhones



Video FPS & Resolution

What video settings to use?

Normal Personal videos – Use
Default

FPS – 30 + HD (1920x1080)

Professional – broadcast

FPS – 60 + 4k

Space Considerations

1 minute video 4K @ 60 FPS = 400 mb

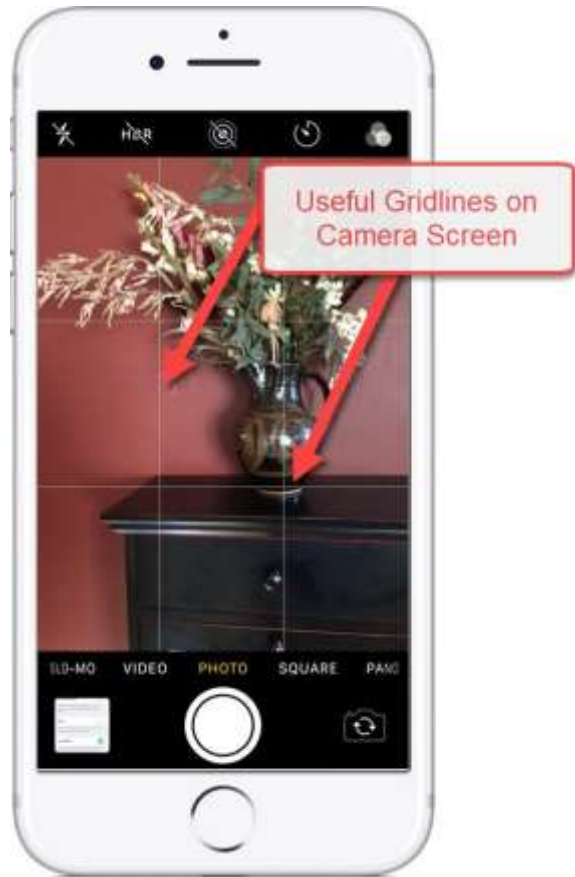
