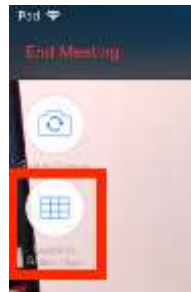
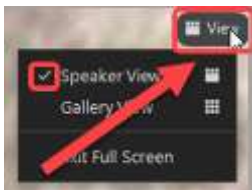

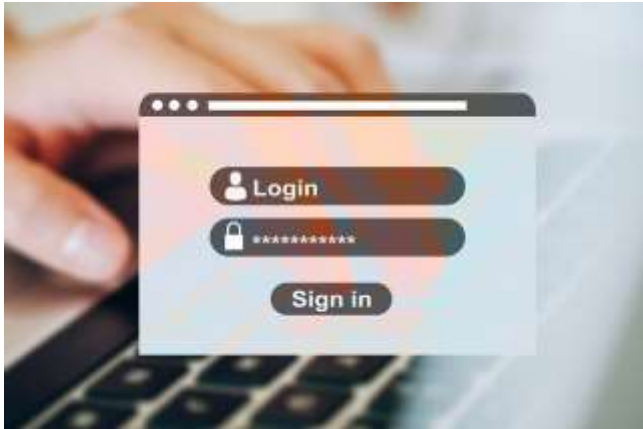

Use Strong Passwords

from SHIFT Workshop – 1/27/21

- ✓ Never use personal information like children's names or address information or even car license plate.
- ✓ Use a longer password. Your password should be at least six characters long and eight characters is better.
- ✓ Try to include numbers, symbols, and both uppercase and lowercase letters.
- ✓ Avoid using words that can be found in the dictionary, place names even acronym or common sequences like "abcdef."
- ✓ Random passwords are the strongest.
- ✓ Don't use the same password for each account.

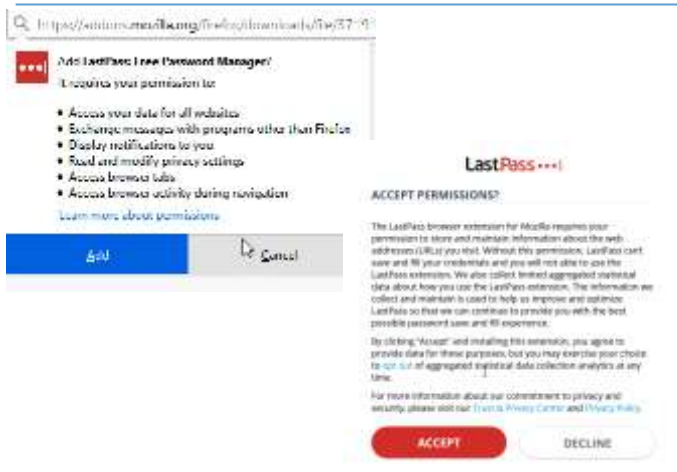

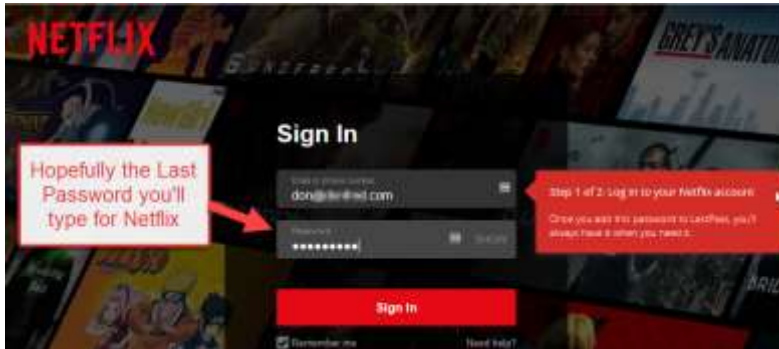
1. Click on one of the four sites to go to that sites log on page.

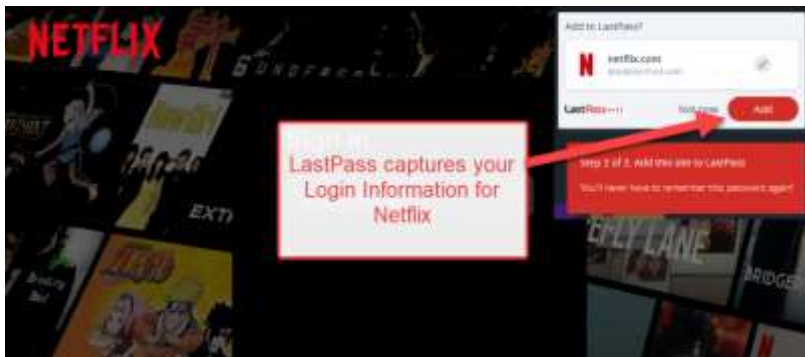

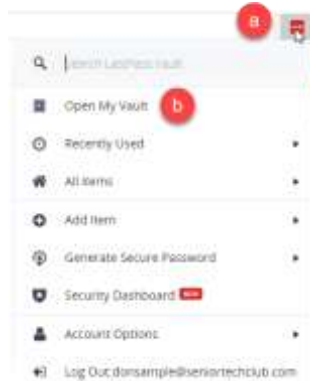

2. Click on your browser extension icon (a) in your tool bar and select (b) Open My Vault



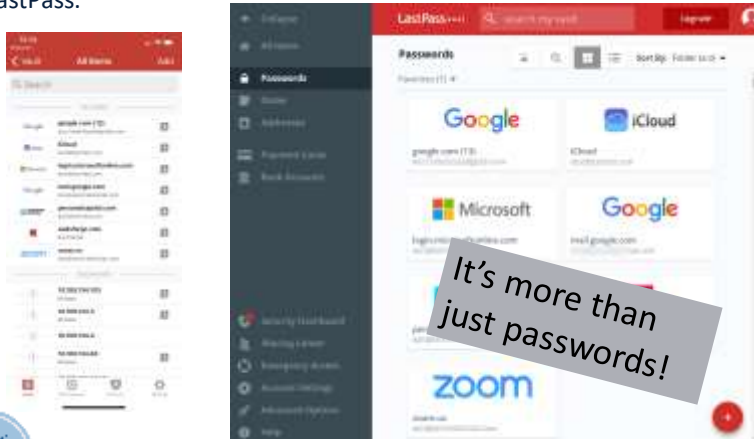

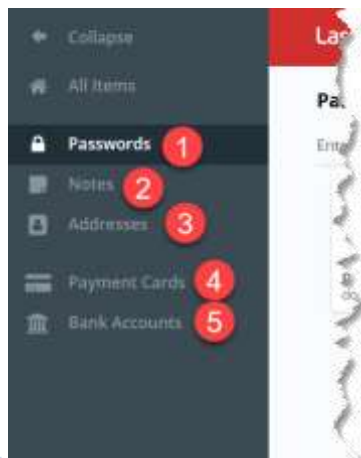
Where you can add, view and manage items that you've saved to LastPass.

More than just storage for your Passwords



Passwords – the usernames and passwords of your sites

Notes – Important pieces of text information, e.g. lists or important information, e.g. insurance policy #'s

Addresses – Use to help fill out forms

Payment Cards – Use to help with online transactions

Bank Account – Reference your bank account numbers and contacts

3. Import from other Sources

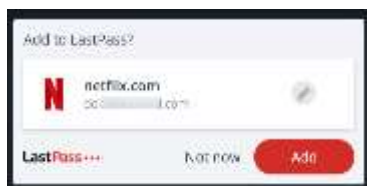

Using your Browser Extension to Capture Passwords

When you log into a site that is not in your LastPass vault, LastPass will ask you if you want to add the information to the vault.

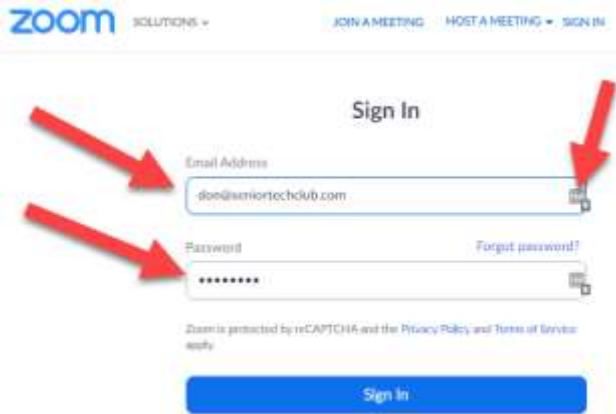

Automatically fill in username and password for a site



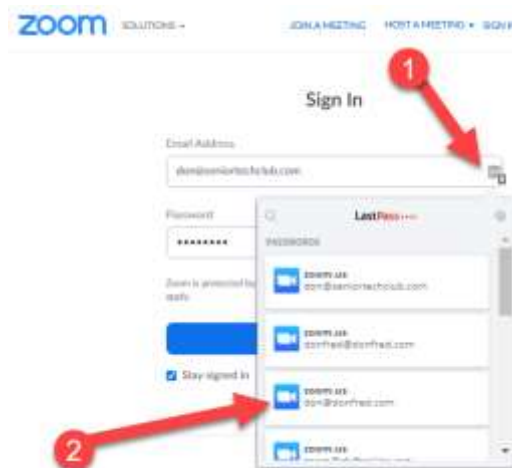

2. Click on the desired login that you wish to use.



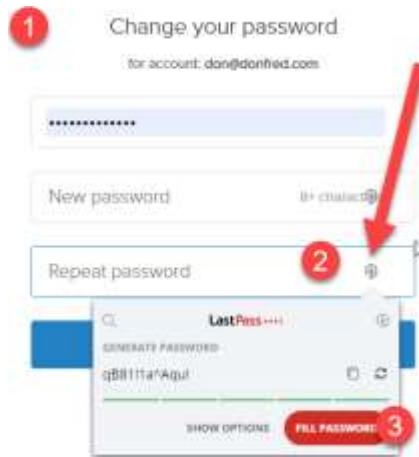

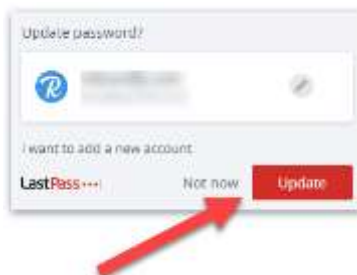
