

What are Virtual Assistants?

A software agent that can perform tasks or services for an individual based on voice commands or verbal questions.

Common examples:

- How old is Betty White?
- Set a timer for 3 minutes.

Apple Siri

Siri – Speech Interpretation and Recognition Interface First VA released an app in February 2010 Acquired by Apple in April 2010 Integrated into iPhone 4S in October 2011

Today, Found in all Apple devices:

iPhones, iPad, Apple Watch, Apple TV, Mac Computer, AirPods, HomePod

Cars via Apple Car Play



Amazon Alexa

Name chosen by developers with a hard consonant for recognition

Released with Amazon Echo smart speaker in November 2014

Today Alexa is available on 20,000 devices including:

- TVs

Virtual Assistant Language Lessons

Understanding the Syntax

Three Steps:

- 1.Invoke/Summon
- 2. Question or Command
- 3. Response or Follow Up



Invoke or Summon

Two General approaches

- 1. Smartphone Button or action
 - Siri press & hold Home or Side Button
 - Google Press and hold Home
 - Alexa Only in the App
- Wake word or Phrase
 - Alexa (can be changed in Settings)
 - Hey Siri (requires setup in Settings)
 - OK or Hey Google

Recommendation – Pause to confirm response



Understanding the Syntax

Three Steps:

- 1.Invoke/Summon
- 2.Question or Command
- 3. Response or Follow Up



Question or Command

Who, What, When, How

What's the weather/time/date

How old is Betty White?

Who is married to Paul McCartney?

When is Easter/summer/Labor Day/Halloween?



Question or Command

Know your essential command words

Set a time or /alarm /re

Set a timer/alarm/reminder

Play music/podcast/sound

Turn on/off light/device



Understanding the Syntax

Three Steps:

- 1.Invoke/Summon
- 2. Question or Command
- 3.Response or Follow Up



Response or Follow Up

This is the Benefit of VA's

Listen for the Response or Confirmation

Sometimes Follow Up



Tips

Pause after invoke

Ask directly – be concise, not

"can you tell me" or "do you know"

Minnesota Nice doesn't add to clarity –Please and Thank you not required but

• There is research that proposes that children exposed to VA environments are less polite. Modeling for children might be appropriate.

Ask only one question or command.

How old is Paul McCartney and how tall is he? (Only Google Completes)

Ability to remember context is increasing. But don't count on it.

- Alexa and Google are better. Siri not so much
- How old is Paul McCartney. Second request: How tall is "he."

Timers & Alarms

Set Timer for x time

Set Timer for 5 minutes

Set Alarm for time

Set Alarm for 7 AM



News & Weather

Give me the News

What's the weather/temperature?



Radio & Podcasts

Play radio (stations by name, call sign, frequency, and nickname)

- Some variation between VAs
- Not all stations are available
- Be more specific in the request if you have a favorite station
- Many radio broadcasts & shows are available as episodes

Play podcast (name)



Radio & Podcasts

Play podcast (name)

- Apple leading podcast provider
- Alexa Select Podcast source from Apple, Amazon Music, iHeartRadio (settings)
- Google Limited to Google Podcasts & Spotify (settings)



Questions, Facts & Trivia

All VAs are a great source of facts and information.

Just ask the question – be concise

- How old is Betty White?
- What is the capital of FL?
- When was Albert Einstein born?
- Is SHIFT any good?



Music in the Home

All VAs are a great way to bring music to your home.

Most music streaming services can be played in most VAs. Research before subscribing.

- Spotify (limited free)
- Apple Music
- Amazon (Prime) Music (limited free)
- Pandora (limited free)
- iHeartRadio (limited free)
- YouTube Music (limited free)



Music in the Home - options

You can play music on your device and use the VA speaker as a Bluetooth speaker.

Multi-Room Groups for whole home music

Integrate VA speaker with home stereo


