#### What is IOS?

Mobile operating system created by Apple exclusively for its hardware.

The software that runs your device.

Includes the Apple built-in apps like Mail, Messages, Phone, Camera & Notes

Other Updates and Patches during the years.




# Home Screen Customization

#### The One Mandatory Skill

For everything we want to change on your Home Screen.

You will need to put your device into:

Jiggle Mode





#### Old vs New

Long Press directly on App icon.

Multiple Options



New for IOS 14

Long Press on a blank part of the screen

Goes directly in design mode



# What can you Do with Jiggle/Design Mode

- 1. Remove Icons & Delete Apps
- 2. Move/drag icons to new location or different screen.
  - Change icons in the Dock
- Create Folders by dropping one icon on top of another
- 4. Add a widget tap + (upper left) widget
- 5. Hide a Home Screen



#### But First... Some Definitions

- Today View
- Widget
- Smart Stack
- App Library



#### Today View

**Today View** is a screen of information accessed from your Home screen that gives you a glimpse of your day and access to the things you do most often.

The daily glimpse might include your schedule, recent messages, weather, news headlines and more.

Swipe Right from your first Home Screen
Can be displayed on a locked iPhone





## Widgets

**Widgets** show you information and provide access to your favorite apps.

Use Widgets on any Home Screen to provide a snapshot of activities, news headlines, weather and more.

Widgets were previously available on the Today View.

Tap a Widget to access the underlying app. Eliminates need for an app icon.





#### Smart Stack

A widget called a **Smart Stack** (one that has dots next to it) is a set or "stack" of multiple widgets

You can add a Smart Stack to the Home Screen, then swipe through it to see the widgets it contains.

More widgets in less space!









#### App Library

The **App Library** is a catalog of your apps.

Found at the end of your Home Screen pages.

Swipe left to access

Organizes all **apps** into one simple, easy-to-navigate view.

Cannot currently be reorganized. Still have folders on Home screen.

Search Bar – tap on the search bar to get an alphabetic list of apps.

- 1. An app doesn't require an icon on a Home screen.
- 2. Removing an app from the app library deletes the app from your device.





#### Design Actions

Move an app icon

Delete an icon or an app

Add a widget

Add a Smart Stack

Hide a Home Screen



# Delete Icons from Home Screen

Jiggle Mode

Tap – (minus) on upper left of app icon.

Delete App – removes app and data

Move to App Library – leaves app on device but icon is in the App Library

An app that you don't use very often doesn't need an icon on your Home screen



# Add a Widget to the Home Screen

Jiggle Mode

Tap + (plus) add on upper left.

Browse or Search to find a widget.

Tap the desired Widget

Choose desired size and element (dots below display)

Swipe left or right.

Senior

Tap Add Widget to place on Home Screen

Tap Done to leave Jiggle mode

## Working with Widgets

#### Delete or Move a Widget

- Jiggle Mode
- Tap add on upper left to delete
- Drag to Move

Edit a Widget (only a few offer edit)

Long Press on the Widget



# Add a Smart Stack to the Home Screen

#### Jiggle Mode

- Tap + (plus) add on upper left.
- Choose Smart Stack
- Swipe to Choose Size
- Add Widget

An assortment of widgets are selected for your Smart Stack



#### Edit a Smart Stack

#### Long Press on Widget

- Choose Edit Stack
- Reorder by dragging grid icon up or down
- Turn on Smart Rotate (device shows relevant widgets throughout the day)
- Delete a widget by Swiping Left Tap Delete

#### Add another Widget

- Add new widget to Home Screen
- Jiggle Mode
- Drag new widget to Smart Stack



#### Hide a Home Screen

With Widgets, Smart Stacks, Folder and that an app doesn't require an icon on a Home screen...

How many Home Screens do you need?

#### Jiggle Mode

- Taps Dots of bottom of Home Screen
- Uncheck Home Screens you with to Hide
- Tape Done



# Home Screen Design Principles

- 1. Most Frequently Used Apps in the Dock
- 2.Place 1 or 2 key Widgets or Smart Stack on Home Screen #1.
  - It might be the time, the weather, calendar, to-do or even sports scores or stock market information. Your choice is not permanent. You may try several over time.
- 3. Place Several Informative Widgets on Today View
  - Battery
- 4. Fill Home Screen 1 with other frequently used apps
- 5. Apps that you don't use very often:
  - Organize into folders
  - Move to later Home Screen
  - Consider whether you require a Home Screen icon



If an app is going to track your activity, you (the users) need to give the app permission to track


App Tracking Transparency (ATT)







  - Tap pin

  - Select Unpin


