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## Use Strong Unique Passwords

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#### Importance of Passwords



Your First Line of Defense to Protect Your Information



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#### Use Strong Passwords

- Never use personal information like children's names or address information or even car license plate.
- Use a longer password. Your password should be at least six characters long and eight characters is better.
- Don't use the same password for each account.
- Try to include numbers, symbols, and both uppercase and lowercase letters.
- Avoid using words that can be found in the dictionary, place names even acronym or common sequences like "abcdef."
- Random passwords are the strongest.

Generate, retrieve, and keep track of super-long, random passwords.

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The Humble Password Isn't Enough

Two factor authentication



Microsoft Reports 2FA will block 99.9% of automated attacks



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#### What does it look like?

- 1. Log in with Username & password
- 2. Verify how to receive temporary code
- 3. Retrieve Code from Text Message
- 4. Enter Code to Complete Login

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#### Pros & Cons

- Add a significant layer to your security
  Easy with a smartphone
  Easy, once you understand it.

#### Cons

- Takes an extra ½ minute to log in
- You need your phone or email
