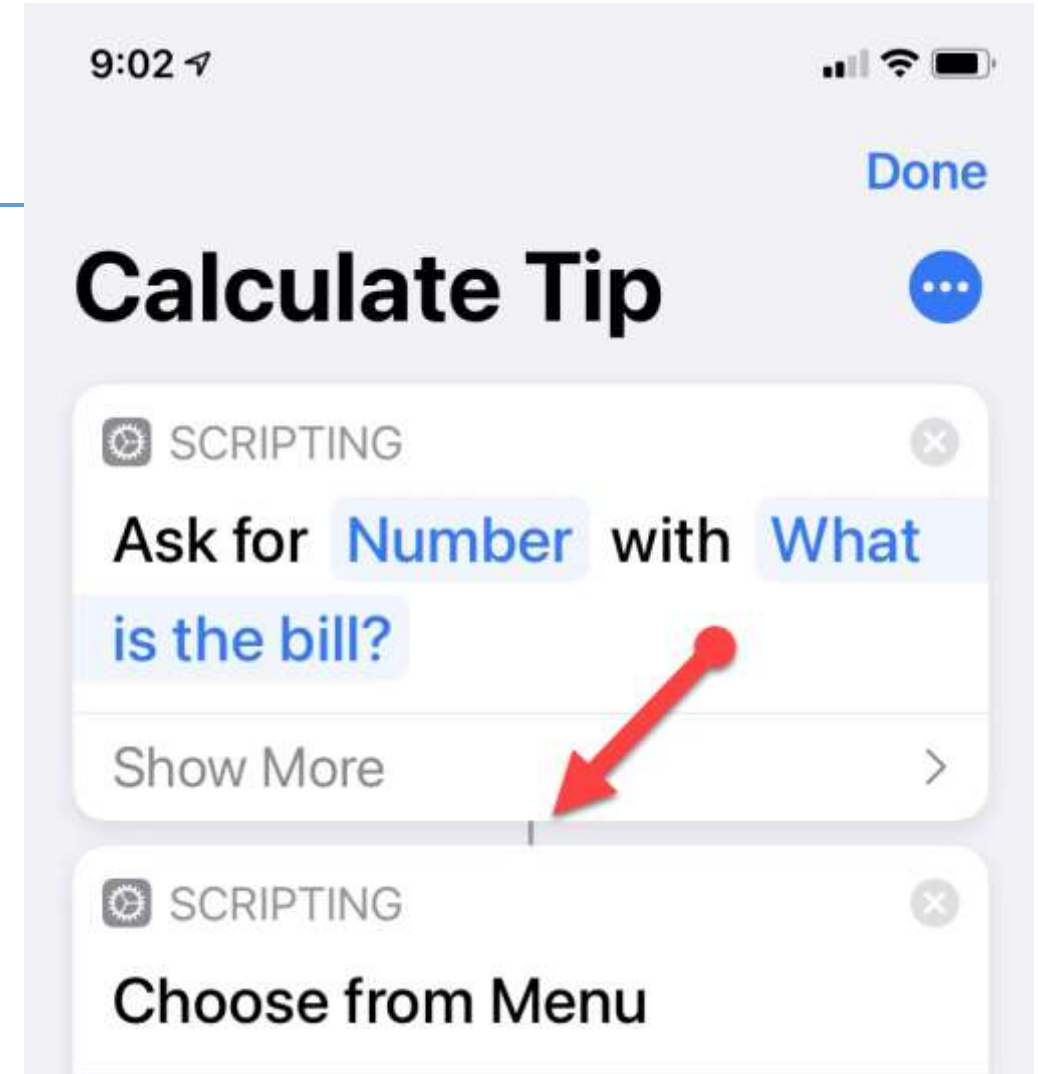


How Shortcuts Work Action Connection

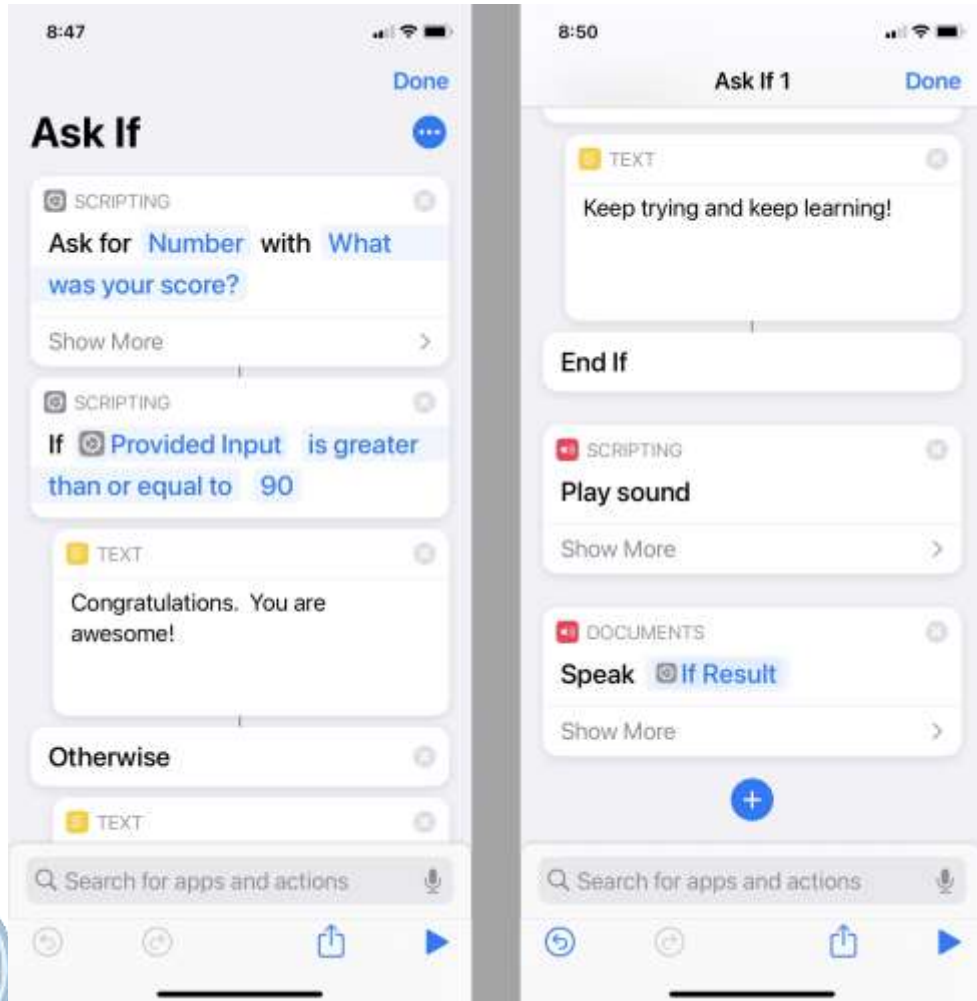
