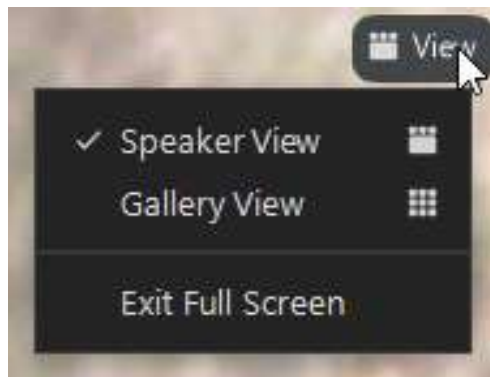

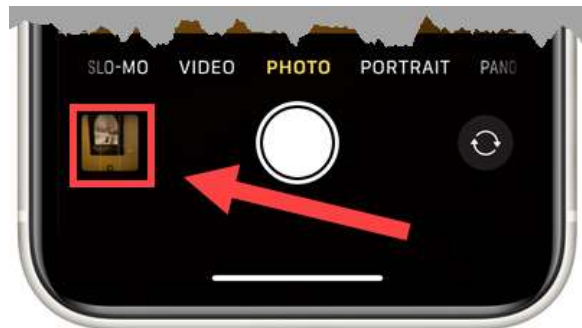

The Photos App


Use the Photos app to view and organize the photos you take.




Displaying Photos

Tap an individual photo to display.

Zoom in or out – Pinch & expand

Share – Tap  to share, organize, copy, print and more (future topic)

Add to Favorites – Tap 

Tap  (upper left) to return to search, album or home location

Tap  to delete a photo from your iPhone

Edit – Crop, Markup, Change

The Photos App

Display a full-screen photo and tap **Edit** (upper right)




Photo Editing is Non-Destructive

Non-Destructive means you can revert back to the original.

Optionally you can Duplicate a photo before you edit.

Recipe to Duplicate Photo

1. Display a Photo
2. Tap **Share** 
3. Tap **Duplicate**

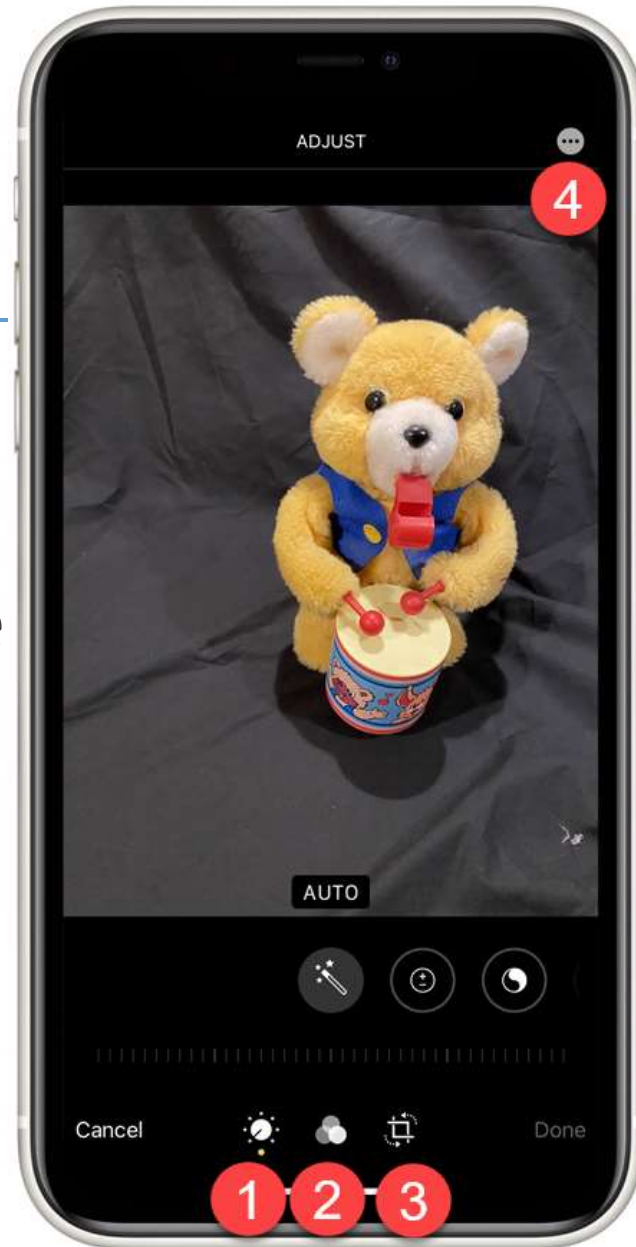


Photos Edit Tour

1. Adjust “dial”
2. Filters-Venn
3. Crop & Rotate
4. More -> Markup

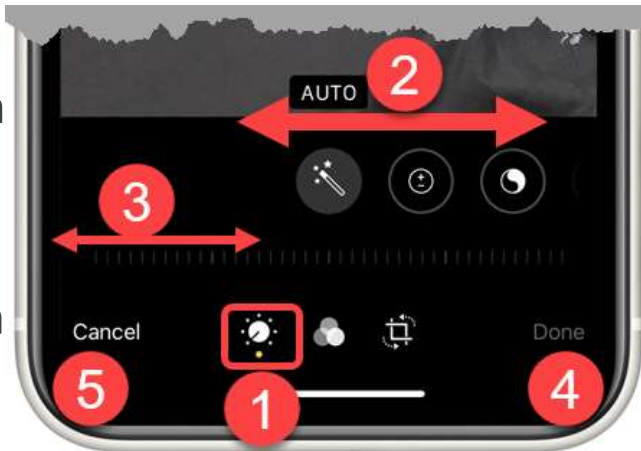
Done = save

Cancel = discard edits



Adjusting Lighting & Color

1. Tap the Adjust “dial”
2. Swipe left & right on row of adjustment tools
3. Swipe left & right on the Scale to tune the photo
4. Done = Save
5. Cancel = Discard



Auto-Adjust



Apple: The best place for a user to start when creating the right look for their photo or video.

...is designed to simplify the photo and video editing process, whether the user is a professional photographer or just getting started.

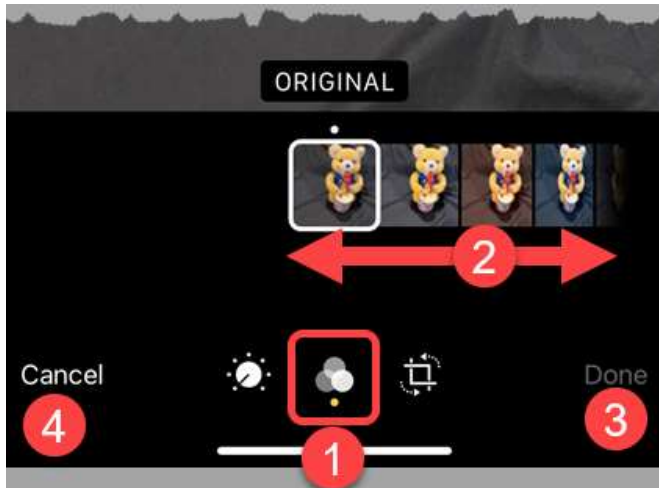
Filters

What would this photos look like in black & white?

Many filter options



Filters



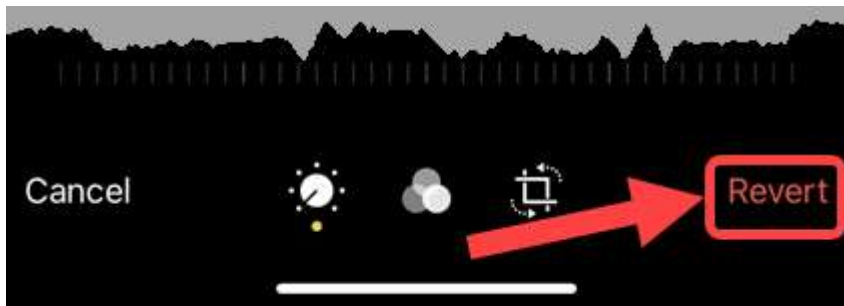
1. Tap Filter (Venn circles)
2. Swipe left & right to select filter
3. Done = Save
4. Cancel = Discard

Revert – It's non-destructive!

If you edit a photo, later you can revert the photo back to its original.

Tap **Edit** on edited photo

Tap **Revert**



Crop & Rotate

Tap Crop & Rotate

Drag corners to move border

Flip Photo

Rotate 90 degrees

Rotate incrementally w/slider

Change perspective

Change aspect

Done = Save

Cancel = Discard



Markup

Hidden Feature


Use it to:

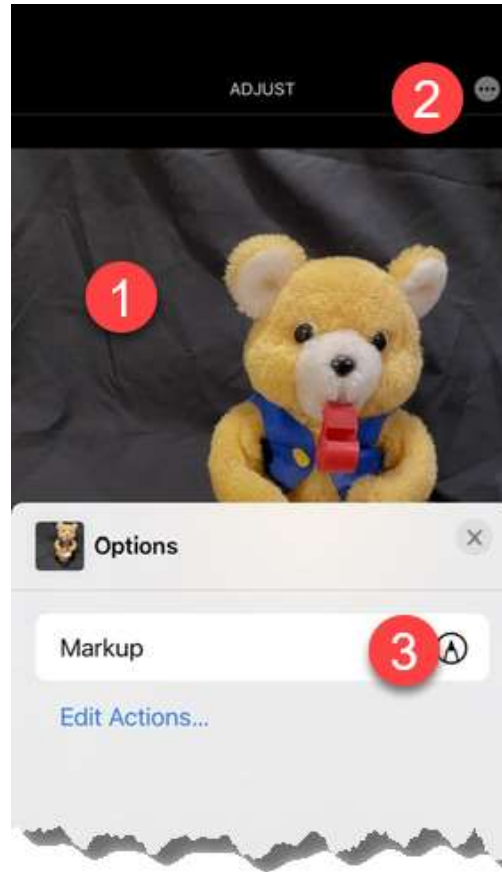
- Draw or Write on a Photo
- Add Text to a Photo
- Add a Shape to a Photo
- Add a Signature to a photo



The Markup Function Secret Recipe

Not Visibly
Labeled on the
Edit Screen

1. Display Photo full screen - Tap Edit
2. Tap More ...
3. Tap Markup 



Writing and Drawing

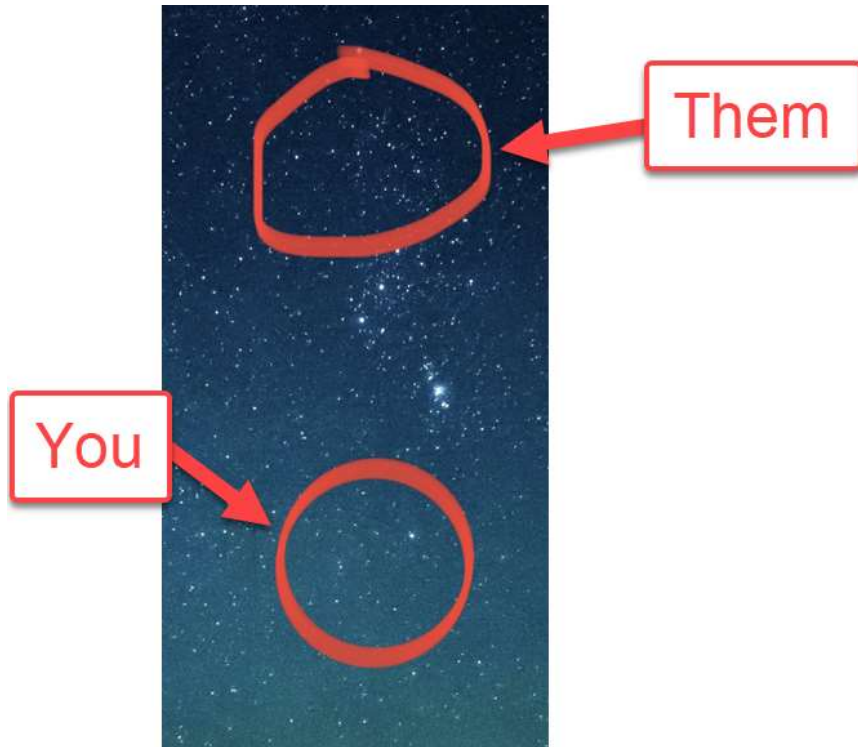


Markup Tools

1. Three Pens – Tap twice to change
2. Color Picker Grid, Spectrum, Sliders & Opacity
3. Eraser – Tap twice for object or pixel
4. Lasso – Circle and alter an object
5. Ruler – Draw straight lines

Who Can Draw a Perfect Circle?

Fun with Kids – Can you draw a perfect circle with your finger?



Who Can Draw a Perfect Circle?

Your Superpower Secret:

When you draw a shape or line, at the end of your movement, pause for a second before lifting your finger.

The shape will snap to a perfect shape.

Use Undo to change back 

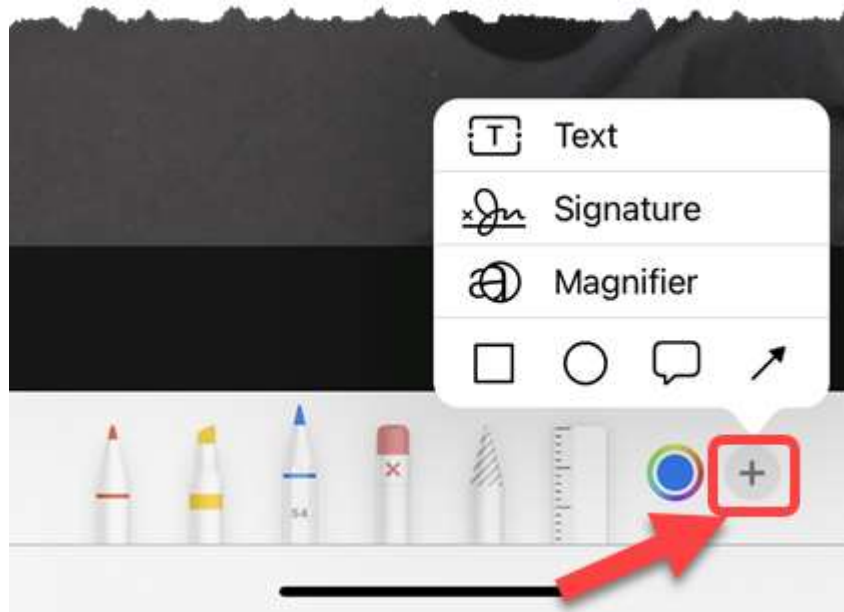
The same secret also works in the Notes app



Add Text, Shape or Signature with Markup

On the Markup toolbar

Tap 



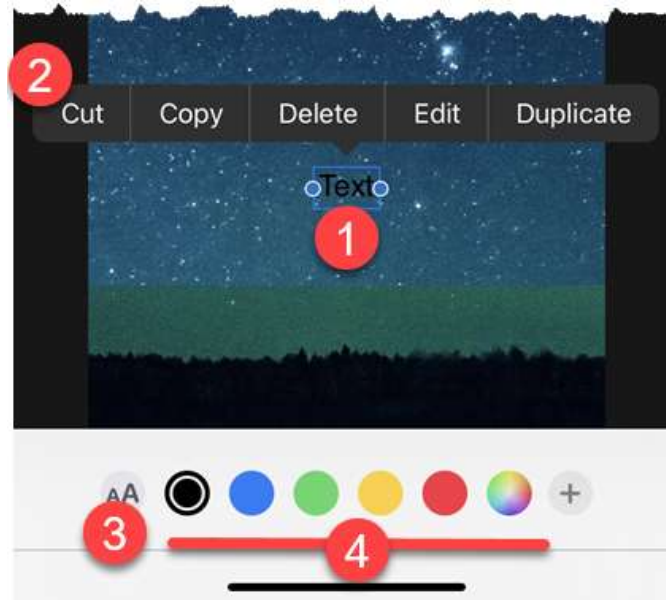
Add Text to a Photo



Add Text

Tap Text

1. A “Text” box is placed on the photo
2. Tap the box to retrieve a menu
 - Choose Edit or Double tap on the box to edit the text
3. Tap **AA** to change the font and alignment
4. Tap Color Pickers to change color
