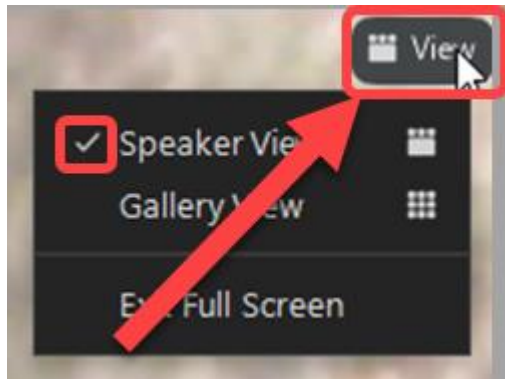

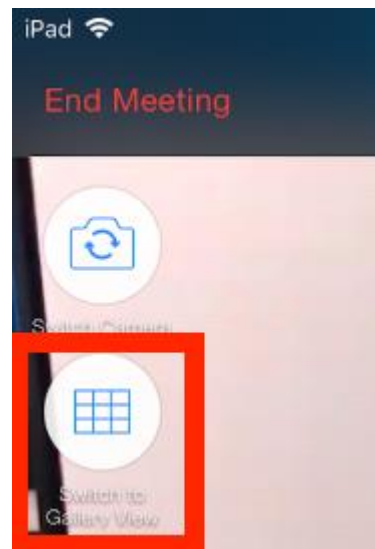

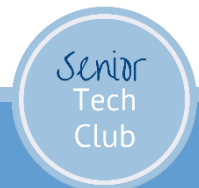

Merge up to five calls into a conference call

Perfect for planning family events

Conference Call Two Step:

1. Add Call
2. Merge Calls



Making Video Calls with FaceTime

FaceTime work with Apple products
(Others use Zoom, Skype or
Messenger)

Group FaceTime calls (iPhones 6s or
later)

Easy to use

Favorite FaceTime Method: Start with
an audio call

Texting & Messaging

This is an essential skill



Group Messages

Texting to Multiple Recipients

Simply type multiple names or
Press + to select from contacts

Caution: Replying to a group
messages sends to all in the group

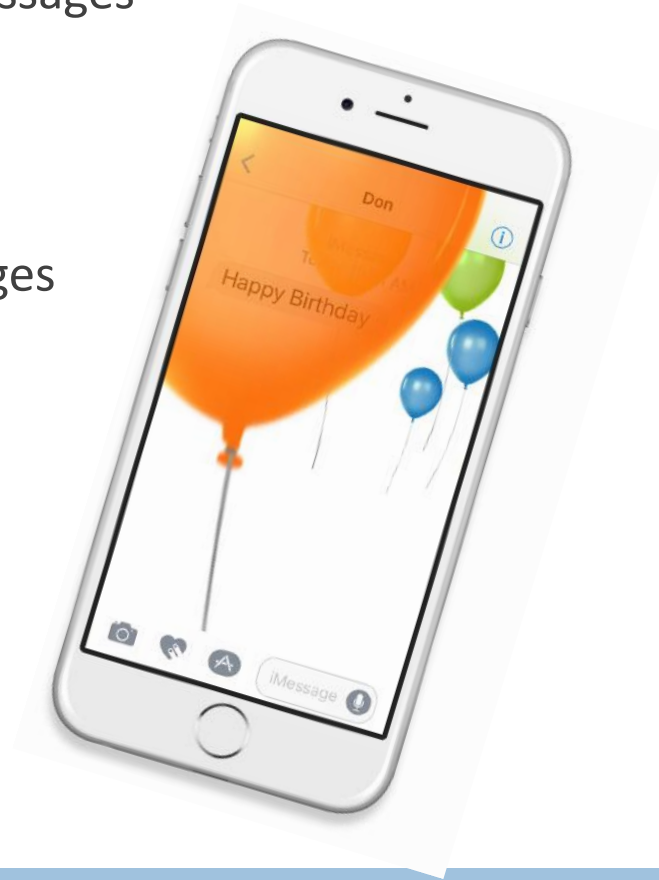
Send Messages with Special Effects

Animation added to Standard messages

- Happy Birthday, Happy New Year, Congrats


Add Custom Animation to messages from other iPhone Users

- Type Message
- Press and Hold Send button
- Choose Bubble or Screen
- Press Send

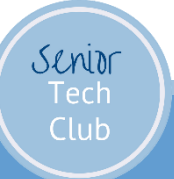
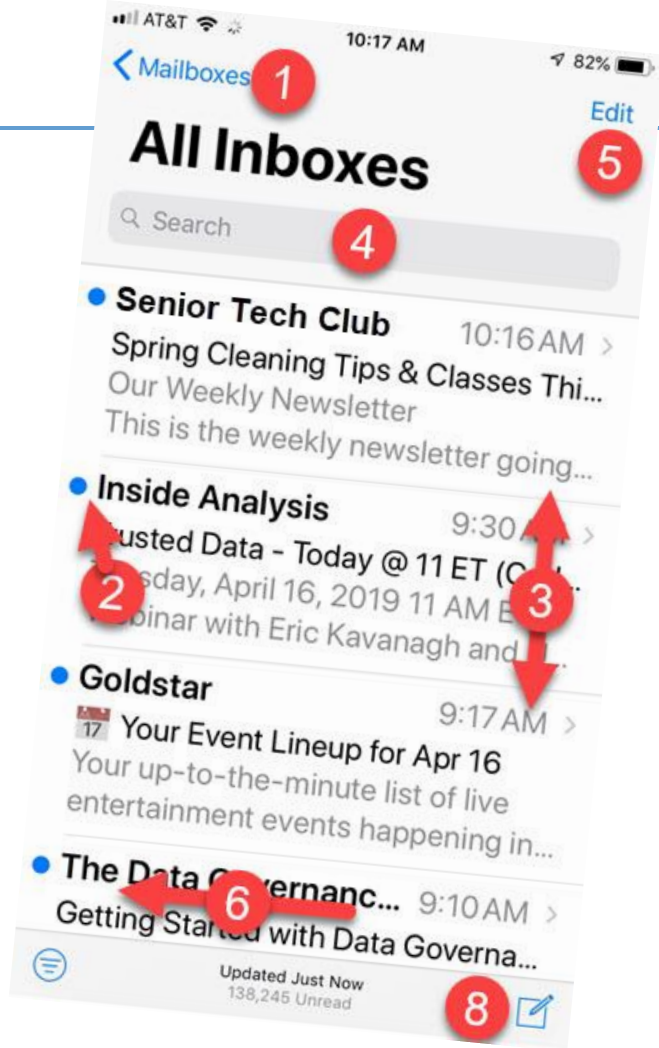


Save a Photo/Video Received via Text

Here are the steps to save a photo or video that you have received in a text message to your Photo Library

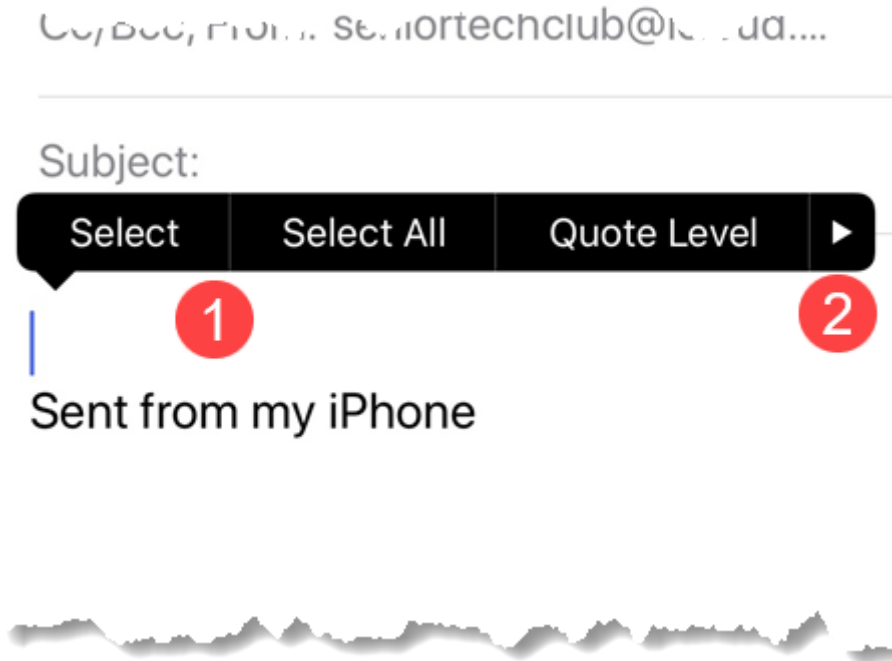
1. View the image in the message
2. Tap the image
3. Tap Share 
4. Tap Save Image

Send & Receive Email



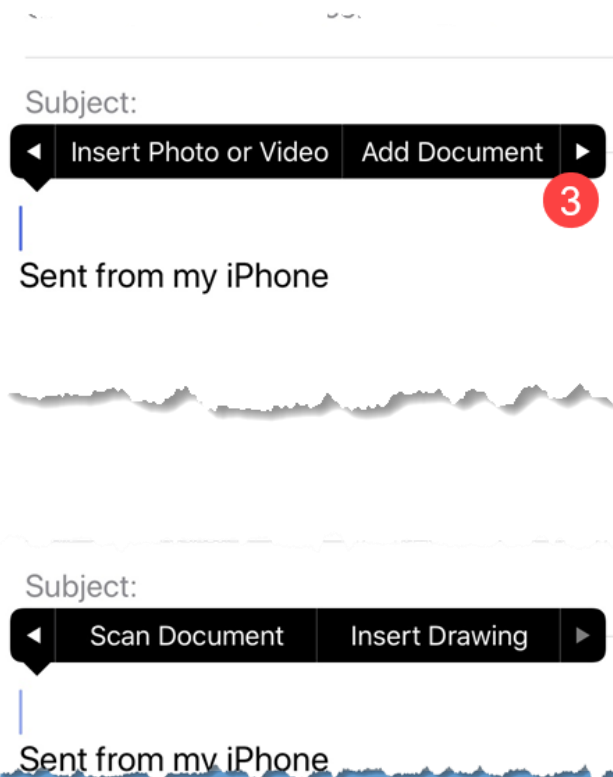
Add Attachment to Emails

1. Double Tap in the Message you are creating
2. Tap Arrow for More (2 times)



Add Attachments to Emails

3. Tap Arrow for More



Dictate text.

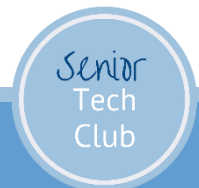
Tap the microphone key

Speak

Tap **Done**

Add punctuation by saying Period,
Question Mark, or Exclamation Mark.

Also say New Line, New Paragraph, All
Caps On

Hi Sally **Comma New Paragraph**

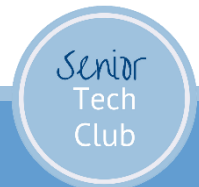
It was good to talk to you today **Period New Paragraph**

Silence Unknown Callers



Silence Unknown Callers

- Do NOT answer call from Unknown Callers
- What is Silence Unknown Callers
- Works best when your peeps are in Contacts
- Setup
 - Settings, Phone, Silence Unknown Callers

Silence Unknown Callers

- If Used:
 - Remember when you ask new people to call.
 - Leave a message asking for a return call.

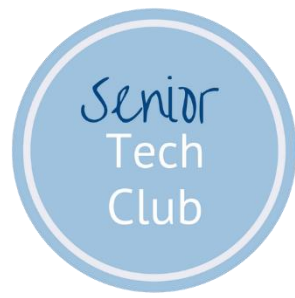

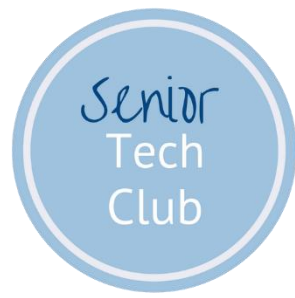
