




# The Photos App

---

Use the Photos app to view, organize & edit the photos you take.



# The Photos App

---

Four Tabs found at the bottom:



Library – Browse your photos and videos by date

For You – personalized album, memories and more


Albums – albums you create albums or use provided albums to organize your Photo library

Search - Search by date, location, caption or categories

# The Photos App on the iPad

Folders instead of Tabs:

- Library
- For You
- Albums
- Search




# Displaying Photos

1. Tap an individual photo to display.  
Zoom in or out – Pinch & expand, move
2. Share – Tap  to share, organize, copy, print and more (later topic)
3. Add to Favorites – Tap 
4. Info (Circle i) 
5. Delete - Trash 
6. Tap  (upper left) to return to search, album or home location
7. Edit – Crop, Markup, Change (Later Topic )

# Search by Date

Your iPhone organizes your Photo Library by date.

Tap **Library**

**All Photos**


Tap **Year, Month, & Days** to browse the photos from that date period.

Total Counts at bottom of Library screen



# Use Search

1. Search Bar
2. Place
3. People
4. Categories




# Search Places

---

Type a City, State, or Country into Search Bar

Swipe on map images for major groupings



Requires Location Access

- Settings, Privacy, Camera

# Browse a Map – Fun Exploration

Go To Albums

Tap the Places  
(Map)

Pinch, expand  
and move as  
needed.




# Search People

---

iPhone will magically organize your photos by people

Tap Search

Tap a Face




# Name a Face

Swipe Up on photo with Person

Tap the unknown face

Tap **Tag with Name**



# Search by Category

Another piece of Apple Magic


Photos will ID photos based on subjects in the photo.

Tap Search

Scroll Down to Categories for examples

Or...

Type a few letters into search bar to reveal possible categories.



# Search by Caption

Fairly New – The ability to put a caption on a photo

Caption is Searchable.

Swipe Up or tap Info (circle i) on a photo to add a caption to a Photo



# The Photos App - Album

---

Four Tabs found at the bottom:



Album – a collection of photos and video clips.

Three Topics:

- Predefined Albums Created for You
- Custom Albums Created by You
- Shared Albums to share with others

# Predefined/Default Albums

---

All Photos (Library)


Recents

Media Types (Albums, Scroll Down)

Places (location services are on)

- Albums, Places
- Search, Places (common locations)

People




# Browse by Media Type

Type = Camera Modes

Tap **Albums**

Scroll down to Media Types



# Predefined Albums That you Fill

---

## Favorites (Heart)

## Hidden (Share, Hide)

- Removes from Recents & All Photos
- Not secured
- You can Hide this folder in Settings>Photos>Hidden Album

## Recently Deleted

- Photos you delete are placed here for 30 days.
- Accidental Deletes are Recoverable





# Better iPhone Photography

Create a Brag Book using Favorites

View under:

- Albums, Favorites



# Custom Albums

---

Albums that you create to organize photos

Unlimited number of Albums

Does not duplicate photos (See my Rules)

Replicate to iCloud & other devices

Great for:

- Slideshows
- Memory Movie

You can organize Albums in Folders (beyond this session)



# Photo Albums Rules

---

Photos are always stored in the Recents/All Photos album. This is the “master” copy of the photo.

- Look for new Photos under Recents

Photos are automatically organized into default/predefined albums, i.e. Media types, People, Places & Categories

- People is the only default album that can be modified.

Create unlimited custom albums to organize your photos for display, printing, browsing, slide shows and sharing.

A photo can be placed and found in multiple custom albums

Photos are only stored once, not duplicated. There is a “master” copy in Recents/All Photos. Custom albums only contain pointer to the master.

When you delete from Recents or All Photos you are deleting the photo from the devices and iCloud

You can remove a photo from an album w/o deleting the photo



# Create a Custom Album

---

## Two Methods:

1. Select Photos first, Share, Add to Album, New Album

- Most Intuitive

2. Create Album First, Add Photos

- Needed if you use Folders




# #1 Select Photos – Add to Album

---

Display Photos (Recent or All Photos)

1. Tap Select
2. Select Photos
3. Tap Share icon
4. Tap Add to Album
5. Tap New Album
6. Give Album a Name
7. Tap Save



# #2 – Create Album First

1. Go to Albums
2. Tap +
3. Choose Album, Folder or Shared Album



# #2 Add Photos

---

From Photo Display (Recents or All Photos)

Tap **Select** (Upper right)

Tap Share Icon 

Tap **Add to Albums**

Select desired Album

Watch the clever animation



# Album Actions

---

How to remove photos from an Album

How to delete an entire Album

How to play a Slide Show from an Album

How to play a Memory Movie from an Album



# How to remove photos from an Album

---

You can remove photos from an album w/o deleting the photo permanently

1. Open the Photos app
2. Tap on the Albums tab
3. Tap on the container Album
4. Tap 'Select' in the upper right corner
5. Select the photos you want to remove (checkmarks)
6. Tap Delete/Trash Can
  - a) Tap Remove from Album or
  - b) Tap Delete to Delete Photo Permanently



# How to delete an entire Album

---

You can delete an entire album without deleting the photos

1. Open the **Photos** app
2. Tap on the **Albums** tab
3. Tap **See All**
4. Tap **Edit** in the upper right corner
5. Tap the red circle (minus sign) on the upper left of the album you want to delete
6. Confirm **Delete Album**
7. Tap **Done**

# What can you do with the Photo Editor?

---

Crop

Rotate

Flip

Correct Skewing

Infinite # of Light and Color Adjustments

Filter (e.g. Black & White)

Draw or Write

Highlight

Add Text Labels

Add Signature

Add Shape (circle, box, arrow)

Magnify a section

Layout (e.g. square)

Trim Video




# Save, Discard & Revert

---

Done = Save


Cancel = Discard



# Edits are Non-Destructive

---

You can always revert to the original.



Revert



# Keep Edited & Original

---

Duplicate photo  
from Share Sheet  
Will copy original.  
Edit the copy




# Photo Editing

---

## Three Tool Sets

1. Color & Lighting
2. Filters
3. Crop & Rotate



# Trim Video

---

Display a Video


Tap Edit

Tap Video

Adjust End Points

Tap Done to Save

- Save Video
- Save Video as New Clip

# iCloud Photo Library

---



# What is iCloud?

---

Apple storage service that you “rent” in the “cloud” in order to store pictures, videos, backup files or other documents

It extends your available storage



# iCloud Photo Library - Highlights

---

## Setup with Optimized Storage

### Take a Photo

Within seconds, the photo is transferred to iCloud Photos (WiFi)

Transferred to other devices with iCloud

Storage is optimized – Full image stored on iCloud, thumbnail on device.



# iCloud Benefits

---

Photos are copied off your device.

Transferred to other Apple devices & Web

- [Icloud.com/Photos](https://icloud.com/Photos) (log in with Apple ID & Password)

iCloud Photo Sharing

Automatic Backups & Find my Phone

Free 5GB of iCloud Storage – not enough

Upgrade to 50 GB for \$1/month – Great deal!



# How to Share your Photos

---

Share Sheet

Share with email or text message

Share with AirDrop

iCloud Photo Sharing

Slideshow

# iCloud Photo Sharing

---

Great for Sharing Photos of an event or vacation.

## Basic Steps

Create a Shared Album

Share with People by name or Choose Public Viewing

Add Photos to the Shared Album (Share Sheet)



# Print Photos with the Walgreens app

---

Create your Walgreens account (login & password)

Find the Walgreens app on the App Store

Log into the app with your account
